BRO. MARSHALL'S MESSAGE

Where Do You Look for Him?

Luke 24:5-6 and as the women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why are you seeking the living One among the dead? He is not here, but He has risen. Remember how He spoke to you while He was still in Galilee.

The women who followed Jesus had gone to the tomb to anoint him with spices and, WOW, they found that he was not there! The angels' response was interesting. Basically, do you not remember what he told you? He said he would rise from the dead, so why are you seeking him here? He is alive!

Where are you looking for Jesus? Jesus said in Matthew 25, "when I was hungry, thirsty, a stranger, naked, sick, and in prison, you helped me. " The people asked, "when did we see you in these conditions and help you?" Here is the important part, "whenever you did it to the least of these, you did it to me." So again, where do you look for Jesus? Where should we ? We must look for him among those who are hungry, thirsty and naked, those who lack basic needs. These could be homeless, in third world countries, orphans, etc... We must look for him in among the sick. Those in the hospital, in hospice, or at home sick. We must look for him in prison. This is pretty specific. Those who are in a physical prison or imprisoned by sin need a visit, they need a friend, and mostly they need the gospel. How are you looking for him among these people? Are you giving to Annie Armstrong, Lottie Moon, Golden Offering, Baptist Global Hunger Sunday, or others? Are you serving in food pantries, clothes closets or other needs based ministries? Do you participate in a visiting ministry? Are you sharing the gospel with those who need it? Are you going on mission trips? We cannot sit in our pews every Sunday and expect to see Jesus changing the world. We must look for him and join him where he is working!
