Bro. Marshall's Message

Teach These Things

Deuteronomy 6:6-8 These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart. And you shall repeat them diligently to your sons and speak of them when you sit in your house, when you walk on the road, when you lie down, and when you get up. You shall also tie them as a sign to your hand.

A few things I want to make clear before I draft this article. First, as fathers, so many times we are doing the best we can in the moment. There is no "rule book" for parenting, but the scriptures are a great guide. Second, "fool proof" does not exist, we will make mistakes and children grow up and must make their own decisions. Third, nothing I say here is to hold myself up as a great father, I am not. I am a sinner, using the Word to raise my children the best I can.

The scripture above says to repeat God's commands diligently to your children. Everyday, in word and deed. We have heard said so many times, "most things are caught not taught." Your children watch you. We started having family devotions early with our children, at the time just Thomas and Viv and continued that on to today. We are not perfect, devotions do not happen everyday, but as often as we can. We read the word, discuss it, give thanks to the Lord for tangible things and pray. When we moved overseas, we saw God work in our children in many ways. Viv, started helping with a deaf ministry, learned sign language, and saw many deaf come to faith. She also taught at a deaf school, allowing her to make relationships with more people. Thomas, being in boarding school, did not get to do ministry with me often, but when he was on break, he would travel with me and help with trauma counseling of refugees. Viv and Thomas translated for doctors in Milan, Italy for refugee health screenings. Lalise, trained many in evangelism methods, not overseas but in Virginia at her high school. Abebu did the same, as she led her middle school Bible club. Gus helped in preparing solar radios loaded with scripture to go out to many new church plants. God is now working in Gus' life in calling him into ministry. He is still not sure what exactly, music, missions, or pastor, but as I told him, he has time to figure that out with God's help and in His time. Did I do any of this, NO! The Holy Spirit did this in my children's lives. Have they had problems, gone down the wrong road at times, YES! But one thing I know for sure, they all know that they have a father who is not perfect but who loves the Lord above all things, his wife and them. They have seen me fail. They have seen me at extremely low points in my life, but they have seen me get back up only in God's grace and now know that they can do the same. As we think about Fathers' Day, I want to encourage you to do the same.
