Bro. Marshall's Message

Are you seeking the kingdom of God or the kingdom of you? What is the kingdom of God and how can we seek it? Mark 1:15 says, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel." Jesus brought the kingdom of God to us as the physical representation of the kingdom. Therefore, we should be seeking Jesus, to be with him, his presence, to be more like him, to live as he lived and love as he loved. However, we are so accustomed to going after what we want, our desires and dreams, because we are told by culture that this is most important. That we deserve it. We had friends in Ethiopia that lived out in the countryside, no electricity, no running water, but clean air, clean living all around, good homegrown food, etc! Their kids always talked of moving to the capital city, 8 million people, pollution everywhere. When asked why, they'd say, "To get a job so I can send money back to my family." What we tried to help them understand was, there are no jobs. Many people come with the same idea, and they are mostly living on the street with no money and no food. You see, they were seeking what they desired but would get trash. That's what happens when we seek the kingdom of us, we get trash. Things fall apart and don't go the way we had planned, but when we seek the kingdom of God, he provides what we need, not want. Now, the more we seek the kingdom of God, our wants and his wants begin to line up. That's where we want to be.

So how do we seek the kingdom of God? We seek it by being with him. What does it look like to be with Jesus? Reading the Bible, meditating on scripture throughout the day, focused times of prayer (not just asking for things), fasting, being still, quiet, and much more. How are you being with Jesus today? This week? This year?
