## *Bro. Marshall's Message*

### **Be Bold**

Be bold in speech, but what do you say? Research shows that most Christians want to be obedient and share their faith, but the common excuse is, "I don't know what to say." There are many tools out there. Romans Road, FAITH method, Three Circles, One Minute testimony, etc. and all of these are great tools, and not one is better than the other. However, we know that "faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God." (Romans 10:17). Therefore, we must share something.

While serving at a church in Virginia, I started a project where once per month on Saturdays we would gather at the church then go out in teams knocking on doors in our surrounding neighborhoods. Before we did this however, we had an evangelism training for anyone in the church that wanted to attend. One Sunday a lady in her 70's came to me and said, "I don't think I can do this, but I am going to come to the training anyway." She also told me that she was afraid and was not good at talking to people. The day of the training, she was the first one there, soaked up everything and took part in all the practice activities. At the end of the day, we divided into groups of five and went to lunch at various restaurants in town with the assignment of sharing with someone while we were out. She was in my group. Using the material that we had trained her; she was able to share the gospel with our server that day! After lunch, we assembled back at the church and had a time of testimonies and reflection. Many people shared that day, but what she said stuck with me the most. She told the group how scared she was to even attend the training, how God kept working on her heart about the fact that she needed to be there, how she came to me on that Sunday and told me she was coming, how she had learned so much, but the thing she said that really got me was this; she said, "I never knew how easy it would be to share the gospel with someone when you know what to say and are prepared!" So, this lady was scared, an introvert, and never shared the gospel before, but stepped out that day in **BOLDNESS** and found out that it was easy!

Do you know what to say? Are you prepared to share? If not, ask your pastor, or call the association. Be bold!
