## Bro. Marshall's Message

### Be Bold

I received a strange text. It read, "Diamond told me to contact you." Ignoring the text, I went on with my day but received another later in the day from the same number that said, "I am Mohamed, a believer in Jesus Christ from Somalia." Now this concerned me. I had no idea who this person was, and many times Muslims would try to insert themselves into thriving mission's efforts with the plan of derailing the effort or even persecution of the believers involved. A new MBB (Muslim Background Believer) had to be vetted and personally vouched for by another MBB, much like when Barnabas vouched for Saul with the Apostles in Jerusalem. So, I went to meet him with another MBB friend of mine. My friend and I had a seat and began to ask Mohamed to tell us how he came to know Jesus as his Lord and Savior. He told us of how he had always had problems with his eyes, and a medical clinic was offered in his hometown by Diamond and some other friends of mine. (I finally realized that he was saying Damon, he just did not know how to spell it on text.) At the clinic, he heard the gospel and came to faith but had not been disciplined and was now attending the university in our town. Mohamed was seeking discipleship.

I began to disciple him and train him how to share the gospel with others. God blessed him with much fruit and soon he had started discipling other MBB's on the university campus. Mohamed called me one evening extremely excited about a student who had asked him to meet him for tea because he wanted to hear about Jesus. I did not hear from Mohamed for almost a week after the meeting and began to get worried. He called me one morning and told me that this student had set him up and he had been abducted by several men, blindfolded and tied up. They smashed his cell phone and beat him. Every day of his confinement they would pour cold water on him and tell him that if he did not convert back to Islam, they would kill him. He told them that if he died, it was ok because he would be with his Savior. After several days, they dumped him at the university and some of his friends took him to the hospital. I met him the day he got out. I prayed for the right words to say to encourage my friend, but nothing came to me. When I arrived to pick him up, he limped across the street with a big smile on his face (scars and missing teeth) and he told me how he was proud to have suffered for his savior! I did not have to encourage him. The Holy Spirit had already done that!

Jesus Christ gave his all for you! Is he not worth you giving all for him? How are you being bold in sharing your faith?
