Bro. Marshall's Message

Be Bold

We are told in Matthew 28:18-20 that we are to "go and make disciples". You see, Jesus never separated evangelism from disciple making. To him this is one thing! After all, you cannot make a disciple unless you first share the gospel. Therefore, we must be bold in our disciple making as well as in our gospel sharing. Making disciples can be messy. As we make disciples, we are really getting to know people and what comes with that is all the good and bad. We are living life together.

When I was in Virginia, I would meet with my D Group facilitators monthly to check in and see how their discipleship groups were progressing. As I was meeting with one facilitator, she told me that the prayer time in their group had gotten stale. People were requesting the same prayers for the same things every week. I asked her to give me an example, and she told me about a lady that was asking for prayer for a neighbor to come to faith each week. Now this is a good thing! We should pray for people to come to know Jesus as Lord of their lives, but I asked her, has the lady ever shared the gospel with her neighbor? You see, often, we pray for people in our lives to come to know the Lord, but we are expecting someone else to share with them. I believe that many times, in these situations, God is waiting for us and giving us opportunities to put feet to our prayers. So, I told her to ask the lady. Part of discipleship is pushing people out of their comfort zones. We met again the next month, and guess what? This lady had never thought about that before. She was praying for her neighbor but had never actually shared the gospel with her. When she did, the neighbor came to faith in the Lord! Boldness in discipleship is necessary. We must hold each other accountable to what the Lord has commanded.

When we do, he and he alone is glorified!

Where are you being bold in discipleship? Are you in a discipling relationship now? I had someone tell me one time that we should all, always be discipled and be discipling others.
